We want to remind you that your child will participate in the 2019 Indiana ILEARN Spring standardized testing during the weeks of April 22 thru May 17. Students will have computer adaptive tests (CAT), performance tasks (PT), and fixed form tests. Grades 3-4-5 students will be testing in the areas of language arts and mathematics. Grade 4 students will also test in the area of science. Grade 5 students will also test in the area of social studies. Testing is completed on Chromebooks. **Students must have a working pair of ear buds or headphones for testing.**

To ensure your child has the best opportunity for success on the testing sessions, we offer the following suggestions:

1. Look upon the testing in a positive manner and encourage your child to listen carefully to directions and do their very best work.
2. Get a good night's sleep before the testing days.
3. Eat a good breakfast either before coming to school or in our cafeteria before going to class.
4. Dress comfortably.
5. Make every effort for perfect attendance during the testing times.
6. Please make sure your child does not have a cell phone or other device that could cause a testing disruption.
7. **Note:** Grades 3-4-5 ILEARN students will test online for these testing session.

It is very important to express confidence in your child and assure him/her they are going to do a great job on the testing. We thank you for your assistance in this important program and assure you that we will do everything possible to make this a positive learning experience for your child.
